

REBATE OFFER:

Weatherization & Equipment Rebates are available through the Delaware Sustainable Energy Utility's Energize Delaware Program to assist customers in making energy efficient home improvements. This program is available from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020 to eligible Delaware homeowners. All Weatherization & Equipment Rebate Applications must be received prior to the installation of measures and must be preapproved by Energize Delaware in order to reserve rebate incentive funds. Each project's associated savings must result in reduced electricity and fossil fuel energy use due to improvements in energy efficiency.

ELIGIBILITY:

Weatherization & Equipment upgrade installations must be new and completed in a residential dwelling or qualified Downtown Development District in the State of Delaware. Each home will receive an Energize Delaware comprehensive energy assessment report (CEAR) completed by a Building Performance Institute (BPI) certified contractor in order to qualify for weatherization and equipment upgrade incentives. The home will be modeled using the OptiMiser software tool which collects and interprets home health and safety issues, energy savings, direct installed measures (DIMs) and estimated costs which will be delivered to the home owner as a report. All Weatherization & Equipment installations must be installed by licensed contractors with the primary contractor being on the Energize Delaware approved contractor list.

COMPLIANCE:

- 1. All projects must comply with the applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations, including building codes;
- 2. Weatherization & Equipment upgrade projects must be installed in an existing building and must be rebate eligible measures as defined by the Energize Delaware eligible measures list posted online;
- 3. Rebates or incentives are not available for new construction, building additions or major renovations.

DELIVERY:

Applications must be submitted to the Efficiency Navigator system for rebate reservation and approval.

APPLICATIONS:

Applications must have complete information and be submitted with:

- 1. The entire completed proposal signed by the Customer;
- 2. An itemized invoice from the installing contractor for the project which includes a separate line item for each installed item and include the date, installation location, install date, customer name, and total installed measure costs, if applicable;
- 3. Air sealing projects must include documented pre- and post- cfm50 Blower Door readings;
- 4. Duct sealing projects must include pre- and post-cfm leakage Duct Blast readings;
- 5. If also applying for attic and/or wall insulation, square footage, insulation type, and R-value of attic insulation pre- and post-installation must be included;
- 6. All Weatherization & Equipment upgrade rebates will be made payable to the contractor unless explicitly listed to pay to the customer on the approved test-out form;
- 7. Energy OptiMiser customer assessment report must be attached to all applications.



PAYMENT:

A final inspection is required to verify that installed measures and incentives comply with program requirements. Please note that the inspecting contractor may charge a fee for performing a final inspection. Once a final inspection is performed by a participating contractor and completed paperwork is submitted, rebate payments are processed within 4 - 6 weeks. Incomplete applications or non-compliance may delay payment or result in denial of application approval. The Energize Delaware program reserves the right to refuse payment and participation if the Customer or contractor violates program terms and conditions.

INSPECTION:

Program staff reserves the right to conduct on-site pre-inspections, in-process inspections and post-inspections of proposed and installed projects.

TAX INFORMATION:

Rebates may be subject to federal and/or state income tax reporting. Applicant is responsible for contacting a qualified tax advisor to determine tax liability. The Delaware Sustainable Energy Utility is not responsible for any tax liability imposed on the customer as a result of the payment of rebates.

PUBLICITY:

The Energize Delaware program reserves the right to publicize your participation in this program, unless you specifically request otherwise.

PROGRAM DISCRETION:

Rebates are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Rebate amounts and offerings are subject to change or be terminated without notice at the discretion of the Delaware Sustainable Energy Utility.

LOGO USE:

Customers or participating contractors may not use the Delaware Sustainable Energy Utility or Energize Delaware names, or logos in any marketing, advertising, or promotional material without written permission.
