Contractor Renewal

Renewal Process to be completed in Efficiency Navigator by October 1st

Required Documentation:

- Signature page of the <u>Contractor Participation Agreement</u>
- Signature page of the <u>Contractor Operations Manual</u>
- Copy of Delaware business license
- Copy of General Liability Certificate of Insurance
- BPI Certifications, if a requirement of the Company's trade
- HVACR license, if a requirement of the Company's trade



NEW PARTICIPATING CONTRACTORS who have registered within the past 90 days DO NOT need to complete renewal process
